Following both academic and extra-curricular activities have been conducted under IQAC of the college.

Monitoring effective implementation of Action Plan – 2015-16,

1. Conducted an Orientation Program for all the first year students about how and when to use library, gym, and how to approach college administrative office for queries etc.,
2. INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DAY – it was conducted on 12.8.2015 by Dr. G. Tirumalaiah, lecturer in Commerce and in-charge Principal. Dr. Lavanya Ayurvedic Hospital, Srisailam was invited as the chief guest. In her speech she said the aim of International Youth Day was to bring out social responsibility from youth, and every responsible youth might have the qualities like physical fitness, mental awakening, and stability in emotions, acceptable to society and possess high ethics. People with these qualities would develop the society which would result in international peace. Mr. Ch. Rajkumar, convener of RRC and a lecturer in Commerce, and other lecturers have reiterated the importance of being disciplined and following principles in life and asked to be informed the dangers

associated with HIV and AIDS. Mr. G. Chandrasekhar, Physical Director, NSS Program Officer explained the importance of physical and mental health which could be attained through playing sports and games regularly.

3. PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME – on 15th September 2015 as part of IQAC program, Dr. P. Malyadri, Principal and IQAC coordinator Sri. J. Pauldayakar, lecturer in History department has invited Sri. Y. Mohan Rao popular industrialist and great motivate speaker to the college to interact with the students on Personality Development. While interacting with the students he said it's only the wisdom and courage that could bring value to a person but not money. One should never worry about failures of the past but should learn a lesson from it and move ahead.
4. TRAINING ON EMBROIDARY AND HANDICRAFTS. Organized a training class for the students to those who are interested in learning embroidery and handicrafts. The program is arranged by IQAC. Women Empowerment cell coordinator Ms. Y. Jyothi has invited Smt. Thulasi as the resources person for the program. Smt. Thulasi urged every girl student to get economically empowered by learning skills that fetch a living.

ESTABLISHMENT OF ALUMNI ASSOCIATION – ever since the college was established the college has produced many graduates. Most of them are well educated and settled in life. Keeping certain issues in the college campus which were to be rectified, the IQAC has taken an initiative to establish an Alumni Association. More than 50 previous students have turned up for the first meeting of Alumni association. Keeping a good relationship with the local people is crucial in college over all development. So, the principal has nominated the office bearers of the association to function. The association members also came forward to build a ramp at the entrance. They also accepted to provide fans and tube lights to the classrooms.

5. ANTI-RAGGING PROGRAM – under IQAC Anti-Ragging program was organized to all the students. Sri. Praveen Kumar Reddu. Sub-Inspector of police was invited to provide necessary information with regard to Anti-Ragging and its consequences if anyone indulge in it. He gave incidents that took place in various colleges and universities. As part of ragging insulting, frightening, hurting, raping, kidnapping, murdering, provoking to suicide, exhibiting pornography are usually happening. Those who indulge in such activities six months to 10 years of imprisonment would be awarded and rupees 1,000/ to 50,000 fine also may be imposed. He also warned the students that students should not resort to such activities and if they do their life would be spoiled and they would not get any kind of job security. Anti-Ragging cell was formed with Sri. Ch. Rajkumar, lecturer in commerce as the coordinator. Students would approach the Cell in case of any such activity in the college campus.
6. Conducted a UGC sponsored National Seminar by the department of Economics.
7. Student's feedback on their respective lecturers has been taken every month and IQAC has analyzed them.

8. As part of the campus cleaning SwatchaBharath has been conducted. Students have been divided into various groups. Some groups cleaned the college campus and other groups cleaned areas around Police Station, SBI bank and Government hospital.
9. As part of Yuvatharangam competitions were conducted in various Sports and Games, Rangoli etc.,
10. College Faculty Forum has been constituted. Group discussions, exchange of opinion programs were taken up by each lecturer every month.
11. INAUGURATION OF CERTIFICATE COURSES – IQAC has taken initiation to start Six certificate courses for this academic year. Dr. B. ShankaraVaraprasad the Executive Officer of MahanandiDevasthanam was invited as the Chief Guest for this program. The courses are 1. Digital Literacy, 2. Communication Skills in English, 3. DTP with an emphasis on Adobe Photoshop software, 4. Hand Embroidery as a part of skill development, 5. Computer Literacy and 6. Yoga. The chief guest in his remarks told the students to be open to learn new skills because in the present day scenario one should have a holistic approach attain over all development.
12. AWARENESS INTERACTION ON NAAC preparations – as the part of NAAC preparations IQAC has arranged an awareness interaction class with Dr. Y. Kalyankumar NAAC coordinator of Govt. Degree College, Nandikotkur, Kurnool dist. He has explained all the records which are important to score more points for getting better grade.
13. Class representatives have been nominated for each class. Regular meetings were conducted with them to listen to their opinions and problems they have encountered in the college campus.
14. AWARENESS PROGRAM by Prof. G. Ramaiah, Director National Institute of Rural Development. He said NIRD is planning and executing every activity that help to eradicate poverty in the society. He urged all the teaching staff to sensitize all the students about the ways to strengthen themselves to stand and fight the problems they face in life.
15. GUEST LECTURE ON COMMUNICATION SKILLS IN ENGLISH – under IQAC department of English has invited Dr. Kishore Babu, lecturer in English School of Excellence, Srisailam to deliver a lecture on Communication Skills in English. He explained the four skills that one should develop for better communication. They are listening, speaking, reading and writing.
16. NATIONAL YOUTH DAY – IQAC, NSS and department of Political Science have collectively conducted the National Youth Day on 12th January 2016. Swamy Sri SriSriAthinthyanandaMaharaj of Kadapa Rama Krishna Samag attended the program. In his speech he said youth must adopt to be simple and selflessness and they should have a goal in life. They must thrive to fulfill their goal. He also

said that the youth must practice yoga every day so that they can improve concentration by which they can meet their goals effectively.

17. Awareness on NAAC PREPARATIONS through Skype. Principal Dr. P. Malyadri requested Prof. Guha Roy, Professor in Commerce, Kolkata University to give tips to the staff on how to prepare effectively for the NAAC preparations. She explained how they prepared for it when their university went for accreditation. She also gave information about how Micro insurance schemes and bank loans, problems of farmers and the best ways to utilize the schemes that have are available with the governments.
18. Department of Physical Education has organized Rayalaseema University Intercollegiate Tournament in Volleyball, Kho-Kho and Chess for this academic year.
19. Encouraged the students for active participation in co-curricular & extra-curricular activities in the Rayalaseema University Intercollegiate Tournament, Kurnool. One boy and one girl student in Volleyball, each one in Badminton, Cricket have represented the university in All India South Zone Meet held at various venues in South India.
20. Organized an awareness program for the students in Career planning, counseling and campus placements for the final year students.
21. Conducted Unit Tests and Pre-final exams as per the academic calendar given by the University.
22. NSS unit of the college has conducted a Special Camp in Srisailam.
23. Conducted remedial coaching classes for the slow learners in their respective subjects.
24. NSS volunteers of the college unit have participated at District level Camp got appreciation for their conduct and contribution in the activities during the camp.
25. All the departments of the college have got their MoUs with the several local Organizations.
26. We have conducted a meeting with Alumni and the parents of the students bringing certain necessities required in the college for which they have responded positively to taken up.
