- 1. Following both academic and extra-curricular activities have been conducted under IQAC of the college.
- 2. To encourage the teaching staff to start more Add on and Certificate courses.
- 3. To assign Study projects to the bright students from each subject.
- 4. To encourage staff members to apply for the UGC sponsored MRPs those who have not done yet.
- 5. On 8.6.2017 in a paper statement Principal Dr. P. Malyadri announced that admissions for the fresh students into I year are open and apart from regular BCom, BA and BSc from this year onwards admissions are open for B.Com Computer Applications EM also. There is also UGC Sponsored Certificate course in Communication Skills available for the students. Campus placements are being organized through JKC of our college.
- 6. National Seminar by the department of History: on 21.9.2017 UGC Sponsored National Seminar has been organized by the department of History. Topic of the Seminar was on "Challenges and Opportunities of Indian Tourism". Prof. Y. Narasimhulu, Vice Chancellor of Rayalaseema University, Kurnool has been invited as the Chief Guest for the Inaugural Session. Dr. N.
