

NSS SPECIAL CAMP 2015

A Report

As part of NSS Programs, 7-day Special Camp has been organized at Hatakeshwaram, Srisailam from 08.09.2015 to 14.09.2015. during this camp the volunteers have to stay at the camp site day and night for all the 7 days. A pre-camp survey has been conducted by Dr. P. Malyadri, Principal & Chairman, G. Chandrasekhar, Programme Officer of the NSS Unit along with Prof. Chandrasekhar Reddy, Potti Sriramulu Telugu University, Srisailam.

The following are the works identified to be done during the camp.

1. Inauguration - Laying of the approach road to the Ashram from main road to Ashram.
2. Washing temple.
3. Cutting and clearing the thorny bushes in around the Ashram and plantation.
4. Swatch Bharath-clean and green in the Police station
5. Clearing the thorny bushes in front of SBI bank.
6. Clearing and leveling of play ground at ring park.
7. Cleaning of cow dung inside the cow-shelter at the Ashram – Valedictory function.

Inauguration Function has been conducted on the forenoon of the first day. Dr. P. Malyadri, Principal & Chairman of the college has chaired the function. Sri. Prof. Chandrasekhar Reddy, Potti Sriramulu Telugu University, Srisailam was the Chief Guest. Dr. P. Malyadri, principal in his inaugural speech instructed the volunteers to be motivated throughout the camp. He urged the volunteers to keep the Motto of NSS NOT ME BUT YOU in mind and serve the society without expecting anything in return. He insisted on utilizing every opportunity to learning new things every day and Special Camp is one such opportunity. Prof. Chandrasekhar Reddy said that each place in Srisailam town has great historical importance. Hatakeshwaram is famous for its serene beauty and tranquility. It is said that Sadhus and sages of those days used to spend their life in this very place to attain nirvana. So keeping this place clean is essential. Later, Sri. G. Chandrasekhar, Programme Officer has listed the nature of works to be done during this camp.

On the first day after the inauguration, volunteers started digging the area to lay Approach road to the Ashram. Since, the place is full of rocks and thorny bushes it was quite difficult and challenging for the volunteers. But they enjoyed doing the work. After the strenuous work, the Programme Officer made them to indulge in playing kabaddi in the evening for recreation.

Sri. Srinivasa Reddy, Sub-Inspector of Police has appreciated the volunteers for extending their service in removing the thorny bushes and cleaning the Police Station premises.
