
Survey location



Location: Sundipenta village, Nandyala district, Andhra Pradesh


Classification of respondents based on gender:


Classification of respondents based on age:


Classification of respondents based on education qualification:




Classification of respondents based on profession:



INTRODUCTION ABOUT SURVEY AREA

My survey area is Sundipenta, a small village near Srisaliam and on the right bank of Krishna River. This village has its own panchayat. This area has a mixture of both low income and middle-class families and very few high incomes group. This village is located in the mountain range far from cities in middle of Nallamalla forest. The main income source of the people here is from small businesses and many of the people work for daily wages. There are some government employees who work in irrigation department. But the many of the people are getting their income from small businesses. Tourism is the main key of income to the people who are living here. Even though the area is so peaceful and pleasant, the lifestyle of the people is difficult. This place is so close to nature but too far from basic facilities which are needed.

SCOPE OF STUDY

The scope of study is limited. I have been given 35 houses to conduct survey on socio economic condition of the people. The study has been conducted based on the responses of selected respondents in our area. The responses are collected, analysed and consolidated to understand the status.

METHODOLOGY

Quantitative research is carried out by interviewing people through questionnaire and personal interactions. The data is recorded and consolidated by the students. We found the problems faced by the people. We tried to bring out awareness and proper suggestions are given to the people regarding the problems identified. And finally, project report was written.

> ABSTRACT

The aim of this study is to find out socio economic status of the people living in Sundipenta, which is new education policy 2022. - Government schemes: in this section we get to know if a
 person is eligible to a government scheme or to know if an
 eligible person is getting the government scheme provided to
 him/her.
- Problems faced: in this section we are going to know about the problems faced by the people in the village. All the main problems are recorded and proper suggestions were given and awareness was brought.

All the details are gathered from 35 houses by interviewing people by personal interactions. The data collected is consolidated and the report is written.	ng


> PROBLEM IDENTIFIED AND SUGGESTIONS:

Education

Even though Sundipenta is a small village, there are many positives about the village. According to my survey I had got a good result on literacy rate of this village, but it has to improve more, So I consider education as a problem in the village. After SSE there are no opportunities for the students for their higher studies. Students are moving to other places to find new opportunities. This is a concern even for their families. The education is highly dependent on government and government aided schools and collage. There is only one government degree collage in a very big perimeter for which a bit of focus is required.

Suggestions for improvement of education:

- Boost free education.
- Establish more educational institutions.
- Work on schools and collage infrastructure.
- Bring innovative teaching methods.
- Promote computer literacy.



unemployment

Another problem I found out was unemployment. Most of the people are unemployed in the village. Meny of the people is living on some low scale business. The people here typically earn low incomes and lack the skills and resources needed to improve their livelihood. The only employment opportunity in the village is either irrigation or Devasthanam. Even graduated people are living on their daily wages. Lack of opportunities are making skills fall in vain.

Sanitation

Health and hygiene are a common problem in the recent times. Our immunity is getting low and more disease are spreading in rapid rate. The absence of safe sanitation contributes significantly to the poor quality of life. Most of the people still defecate in open space, most of the people are ignorant about the consequences of poor sanitation and un hygienic conditions. Sanitation is used to define a package of health-related measures. 
- Awareness should be brought to people.

Road

Road problems are one of the major problems in this area. Meny roads have insufficient capacity, poor sidewalks, and many potholes on the road.

It has been a big problem for the villagers. The top layer of the roads has eroded completely. Big potholes and uneven roads have made life miserable for motorist. Innumerable pits have been formed in many spots of the village. Besides damaging parts of the vehicle, the poor roads are consuming more fuel. Water is being stagnated in the potholes when it rains which makes the situation mare worse. Roads play an important role in poverty elevation in villages like sundipenta. It enables transportation of men, material, and goods which leads to bettering the economy of the village.

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Electricity

Medical

There are incidents where people lost their lives or their loved ones just because there is no proper medical facility in the village.

- Proper training should be given to health care workers.



Drainage

one of the challenges that people face in the village is drainage. The poor drainage system and stagnant water have become breeding of various illness. When there are rains, water runs over the road and keeps the pedestrians in a huge mess. Removing stormwater and household wastewater is an important environmental health intervention for reducing disease. Poorly drained stormwater forms stagnant pools that provide breeding sites for disease vectors. Because of this, some diseases are more common in the wet season than the dry season. Household wastewater may also contain pathogens that can pollute groundwater sources, increasing the risk of diseases such as lymphatic filariasis. Poor drainage can lead to flooding, resulting in property loss, and people may even be forced to move to escape floodwaters. Flooding may also damage water supply infrastructure and contaminate domestic water sources.

- Improve soil permeability.
- Divert excess water.
- use closed drainage system.
- Don't make water stationary.



There are many problems in the village. I have addressed few of the most common problems that are faced by the people. Meny of the problems is right under the torch. There is street dogs' problem. The street dog in our village is very furious. There are many accidents happened because of the street dogs.
