




## **Classification of Respondents based on Gender**


## **Classification of Respondents based on Age**




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#### **OBJECTIVE OF COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT**

#### ABSTRACT

A socio-economic survey is regarded as one of the most important sources of statistical data on household expenditure and income as well as other data on the status of housing and individual living conditions .It is considered as one of the most important parts of education for understanding or to know the status of the people of various society. The main aim of this course is to transform the socio economic condition of the people living in rural areas. To transform socio economic condition and to bring out economic development, there is a need to analysis the present condition of the people to bring change in future.

#### INTRODUCTION

According to new education policy doing a community survey is mandatory not only for marks purpose it is also important for development of communication skills. By this survey a student will learn to communicate with people, to ask questions. These types of survey will help a student to come out of their comfort zone and overcome fear of public. Four wall class room is not the only place for learning, society gives us ample opportunity to understand oneself and the people around us. Socio- economic is an important part of education system of education to know the status of people of society, the problems they are facing in the society, the economical status. This survey report is a modest attempt to develop awareness and insights to socio economic study of various social, cultural and economic aspects .This report contains the analytical study of socio-economic factors with practical approach. While conduction the survey we studied the socio-economic aspects, living conditions, health and educational status and the problems faced in the village .The questioner was divided into seven sections which gives full and detailed information about an individual.

• Family details: - In this section the details of the family were taken like the names of the family members, genders, age, their education and their profession etc. in this section all the family details are recorded.

• Social status: - This section is all about the social status of the people of the area. In this section we include perception of one's social standard using categories like SC, ST, BC, OC and religions. The main objective of this section is to understand the lifestyle and opportunities given to each individual in the area.

• Economic status: - In this section the economic status of the person is recorded. This section shows a person's lifestyle. This shows the social standing or class of an individual.

• Health details: - This section is to know about people's health status in a locality. In this section we tried to know about people's health problems faced, their medications and also about any physically challenged people and their challenges faced in life.

• Other details : - this section is all about digital facilities of people. As we know that this is a digital world, this section gathers information about people having digital gadgets like mobile phones, televisions, laptops and internet facilities as these are the things that connects the world.

• Government schemes: - in this section we get to know if a person is eligible to a government scheme or to know if an eligible person is getting the government scheme provided to him/her.

• Problems faced: - in this section we are going to know about the problems faced by the people in the village. All the main problems are recorded and proper suggestions were given and awareness was brought .All the details are gathered from 30 houses by interviewing people by personal interactions. The data collected is consolidated and the report is written.

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PROBLEM IDENTIFIED AND SUGGESTIONS:
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#### Education

Even though srisailam is a small village, there are many positives about the village. According to my survey I had got a good result on literacy rate of this village, but it has to improve more, In my survey I consider education is the major problem in the village. After SSE there are no opportunities for the students for their higher studies. Students are moving to other places to join colleges .This is a concern even for their families. The education is highly dependent on government and government aided schools and collage. There is only one government degree collage near srisailam a very big perimeter for which a bit of focus is required.

Suggestions for improvement of education:

- Establish more educational institutions.
- Boost free education.
- •. Bring innovative teaching methods.
- •. Work on schools and collage infrastructure.
- •Promote computer literacy.

#### unemployment

Another problem I found out was unemployment. Most of the people are unemployed in the village. Many of the people are living on some low scale business around temple . The people here typically earn low incomes and lack the skills and resources needed to improve their livelihood. There is no employment opportunity in the village .The only way of earning by daily Labours or Devasthanam workers. Even graduated people are also having no job and they working on their daily wages. Lack of opportunities are making skills fall in vain.

Suggestions:

- Improve quality of education.
- Invest in technology.
- Invest in physical infrastructure.
- Structural reforms by lower taxes.
- Lower interest rates.

#### Medical

As discussed, earlier health is the most important thing for an individual and to the society. Many of the responders responded that there are very fewer medical facilities in the village. There is no proper hospital in the village. Even though there is a government hospital there are no facilities in the hospital. There are no professional doctors in the hospital. There is actually not enough staff in the hospital. If there is any emergency, a patient has to be taken to city which is 4-5 hours away from our village but here only 2 or 3 ambulance . There are some incidents where the people lost their lives or their loved ones just because there is no proper medical facility in the village.

- Improving healthcare centres in the village.
- Hospitals should have proper doctors and staff.
- Government should invest on hospitals.
- Hospital infrastructure should be developed.
- Proper training should be given to health care workers.

#### Drainage

one of the challenges that people face in the village is drainage. The poor drainage system and stagnant water have become breeding of various illness. When there are rains, water runs over the road and keeps the pedestrians in a huge mess. Removing storm water and household wastewater is an important environmental health intervention for reducing disease. Poorly drained stormwater forms stagnant pools that provide breeding sites for disease vectors. Because of this, some diseases are more common in the wet season than the dry season. Household wastewater may also contain pathogens that can pollute groundwater sources, increasing the risk of diseases such as lymphatic filariasis. Poor drainage can lead to flooding, resulting in property loss, and people may even be forced to move to escape floodwaters. Flooding may also damage water supply infrastructure and contaminate domestic water sources. Suggestions

- Improve soil permeability.
- Divert excess water.
- use closed drainage system.
- Don't make water stationary
